



FUNDRAISING & SPONSORSHIP GUIDE

What will money raised go towards?

Funds raised through sponsorship for the Colour Run will be put towards a new gaga pit and safe play upgrades.

How can my child fundraise?

Fundraising will be managed via the **Qkr** app. Students can ask family or friends to sponsor them by making a donation.

Does my child have to fundraise?

No, **fundraising is completely optional**. All CPS children will be able to participate in the fun run, regardless of whether or not they have fundraised.

Is there a prize for raising the most funds?

There is no individual prize but the class that raises the most funds will get a special lunch put on by the PFA!

How will the fundraising work?

Parents and carers can collect sponsorship or donations on behalf of their child (via cash or electronic transfer) and make the payments via Qkr.

Using Qkr - rather than a third-party fundraising platform - means more funds will go to the school. It also makes it easier for family and friends, as they do not need to create their own Qkr account.

How do I collect donations on behalf of my child?

We encourage you to use the sponsorship form provided and ask friends and family to sponsor your child (or better yet, get your child to ask!) Those who agree to make a donation will simply need to give you the money (either by cash or electronic transfer). You will then need to donate the money via Qkr on their behalf.

I've collected donations on behalf of my child. How do I make the payment via Qkr?

1. Login to your Qkr account
2. Choose Carnegie Primary School
3. Scroll down to 'Parents and Friends Association' (PFA)
4. Click on 'PFA Fundraising & Events'
5. Click on 'Colour Run' in the top navigation bar
6. If you have more than one child at CPS, select which child you are making the donation on behalf of
7. Choose a pre-filled donation option (\$10, \$25 or \$50) OR enter your own amount
8. Click 'Add to Cart' & then 'Checkout'

9. Choose your payment option & 'Submit Payment'
