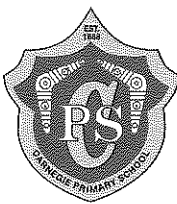

PARENT PAYMENT ARRANGEMENTS 2021

Dear Parents

Carnegie Primary School is looking forward to another great year of teaching and learning and would like to advise you of our parent payment arrangements for 2021.

Student Class Requirements will be distributed in the classroom in the first week of the school year. The materials include stationery, such as pens, pencils and exercise books. We endeavour to keep the cost of books and requirements as low as possible by purchasing in bulk. If you wish to purchase your own Student class requirements please inform the school office by **Friday 20th November 2020** and pick up the list required, so the school can prepare accordingly.

The Online Learning subscription payment covers all students to access Mathletics, Reading Eggs, Typing Tournament, Wushka, See Saw and other online subscriptions to enhance learning both at home and at school.

The Curriculum Consumables includes materials for Art, Discovery, Sustainability and Science eg. paper, glue, clay, paint, cooking materials etc.

The voluntary financial contribution for the Buildings and Grounds is \$30 per student, this goes towards the up keep of the school grounds. The Technology voluntary contribution is \$100 per student. This ICT contribution is so valuable in enabling us to keep pace with the financial demands of resourcing an up to date ICT program for your child/children.

Excursion Levy covers all excursions and incursions throughout the year.

Sport Events Levy includes winter and summer sports (5-6), the lightning premierships (5-6), House swimming and House athletics day (3-6).

Parents who hold an eligible Centrelink Health Care Card are entitled to \$125.00 to be put towards excursions, swimming, camp or sport. The CSEF (Camp, Sport Excursion Fund). Please contact the office for an application form.




Carnegie Primary School understands that some families may experience financial difficulty and offers the following support options:
